- Marion glass gave us a quote for the window that was damaged by the storm over the summer. The quote was for \$1,788. Insurance won't cover it because it doesn't meet the deductible. It would have to come out of our pocket. Alex is going to check into ServePro to see a price for replacing the window also.
- Josh Kuhnert said he was going to try to include the two vandalism windows along with the current broken window and get it paid by the insurance.
- The library suffered damage due to vandalism. Thank you to Charlene and her sister for coming in on Sunday to help clean up the mess. The colorful area rug we had purchased with the floor grant had to be

disposed of and Alex and David cleaned the children's area. Missy said insurance would cover ServePro to come in, so we asked them to come clean it. They did a great job!

- A ceiling tile had to be replaced last week due to a leak in the roof. We had water pooled on the floor.
- We can apply for a new construction loan which is due on February 15th. We have received a free quote from 5 Star Roofing of\$34,750 for an aluminum chip roof. They reached out to Alex.
 - o Alex plans on getting other quotes for the roof.
